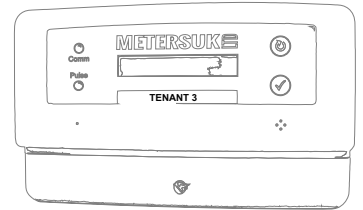
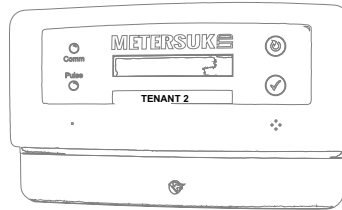
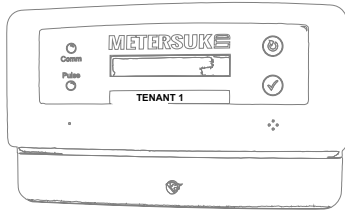


## How do the standing Charges work ?

- \*1 Utility per day charge .25p
- 2 Utility per day charge .45p
- 3 Utility per day charge .55p



Day 1

	Tenant 1	Tenant 2	Tenant 3
Balance	15.65	10.02	72.00
Meters UK Charges	.25	.25	.25
New Balance	15.40	9.77	71.75

Every day .25p is deducted from each meter for Meters UK charges (admin, network, reading)

Each tenant over a 30 day period will have £ 7.50 taken off the money they are paying for their utilities. This amount will vary depending on number of utilities being read\*.

Therefore if a tenant pays £ 50.00 onto their meter for the month, £ 7.50 will be Meters UK charges and the balance of 42.50 will be used for their utilities.

### Example for the month for 1 utility - 25p per day

	Tenant 1	Tenant 2	Tenant 3
Paid through Smartlink	50.00	70.00	100.00
Standing Charge for 30 days	7.50	7.50	7.50
Total for Utilities	42.50	62.50	92.50

End of month account to you will be

$$£ 50.00 + £ 70.00 + £ 100.00 = £ 220.00 - [£ 22.50 (+ 5\% VAT) = £ 23.63] = £ 196.37 \text{ PAID TO YOU}$$

### Example for the month for 2 utilities - 45p per day

	Tenant 1	Tenant 2	Tenant 3
Paid through Smartlink	50.00	70.00	100.00
Standing Charge for 30 days	13.50	13.50	13.50
Total for Utilities	36.50	56.50	86.50

End of month account to you will be

$$£ 50.00 + £ 70.00 + £ 100.00 = £ 220.00 - [£ 40.50 (+ 5\% VAT) = £ 42.53] = £ 177.47 \text{ PAID TO YOU}$$
